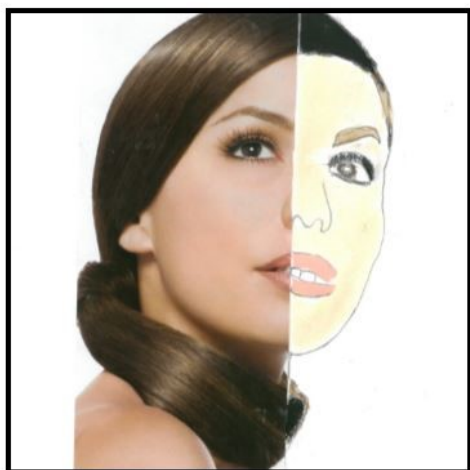

3 Way Conferences

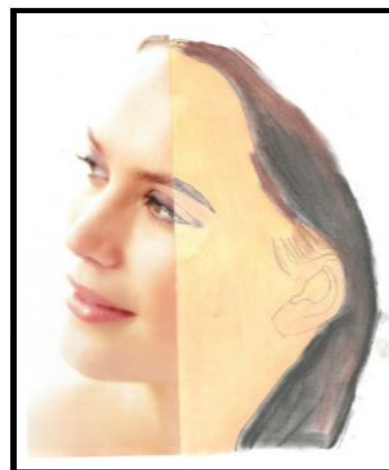
